What kind of legacy can I leave to Chance UK?

You can either leave a specific amount or a residuary bequest. The latter is simply an instruction in your Will that Chance UK should receive the residue, or part of the residue, of your estate; that is to say, the amount that is left after other legacies and costs are paid. This has the advantage that any specific amounts you have left to family or friends will be unaffected.

How will it affect my tax position?

Legacies to registered charities like Chance UK are free of inheritance tax. This means that if the value of your estate exceeds the current tax threshold (ask your local tax office for details) your legacy could reduce inheritance tax liability.

What wording should I use in my Will?

Your solicitor or other professional adviser will help you include the correct wording in your Will. However, If you wish to add a bequest of a specific amount to Chance UK to your existing Will in the form of a Codicil, here is the suggested wording:

“I give, devise and bequeath to Chance UK (charity registration number 1046947) of Units S1/S2, 89-93 Fonthill Road, London N4 3JH, the sum of £___ (___pounds) for its general charitable purposes and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer shall be full and sufficient discharge.”

If you wish to leave the bulk of your money and properties to your family and friends and the remainder of your estate to Chance UK, you might like to word your instructions as follows:

“I give, devise and bequeath to Chance UK (charity registration number 1046947) of Units S1/S2, 89-93 Fonthill Road, London N4 3JH, the residue of my estate (or fraction thereof) for its general charitable purposes and I declare that the receipt of the Treasurer or other proper officer shall be full and sufficient discharge.”
